

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED TO THE LSC BOARD BY MS. PENNY PULLEN

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Legal Services Corporation supports legislative reform of the Federal legal services program, having adopted a resolution expressing such support on June 25, 1990;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that such reform should focus the limited resources entrusted to the Legal Services Corporation on the recognized needs of indigent clients, and should prevent the questionable activities of some legal services programs;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Bill McCollum, the Honorable Harley Staggers and the Honorable Charles Stenholm, distinguished Members of the United States Congress, have introduced legislation known as The Legal Services Reform Act of 1990, the provisions of which have been distributed to the Board; be it therefore

Resolved, that the Board urges the United States Congress to bring needed reform to the Federal legal services program by enacting the provisions contained within The Legal Services Reform Act of 1990; and, be it further

Resolved, that the Board authorizes the LSC staff: to provide technical assistance and support to Members of Congress and their staff; to convey the support of the Board for the provisions of The Legal Services Reform Act of 1990; and, to inform Members of Congress about the implication of other legislative proposals concerning the Federal legal services program.
